KLCOA Art on the Dock 2019 is a community event to showcase artists and artisans who reside/cottage on Kennis and Little Kennis Lakes. It is intended to introduce Kennis cottagers, residents, their guests and friends to the talent and diversity of artists and artisans in our midst, to build the spirit of community on the lake, and to add a cultural dimension to the environmental, social, recreational and economic activities which KLCOA offers to its members.

The information in this registration document will be used to create a brochure and online promotional materials for the event. If you register to exhibit, your name and location on the lake will be posted on the internet and will be printed in brochures to be distributed widely in the Haliburton area. (No phone numbers will be published). If you have a website address for your work, we encourage you to provide it for publication. We ask you to complete this form with the information that you would like to see included in the brochure (noting space limitations). Please note that we reserve the right to edit the material submitted.

Deadline for exhibitor registration is February 28, 2019. Please email registration forms to janis@parkerpad.com. Please note that this is a strict deadline - Exhibitor registrations received after Feb. 28 will not be included in the brochure or other printed promotional material and you will not be provided with signs or otherwise be enabled to participate in the event.

Who can exhibit? The primary exhibitor must be a property owner (or immediate family member) on the Kennis Lakes and a current member of the Kennis Lake Cottage Owners' Association. Primary exhibitors are welcome to invite family members or friends to exhibit with them as guest exhibitors. Please note that to make the event manageable for visitors, we will constrain the number of exhibit locations to a maximum of 12. Preference will be given to locations with more than one artist exhibiting. We would appreciate it if you would be willing to host other artists (in media other than that being exhibited at your location) or if you would be willing to join another exhibit location. Once registration closes on Feb. 28, we will contact artists where necessary to make arrangements to attain a maximum of 12 exhibit locations. While every attempt will be made to accommodate artists in their preferred locations, KLCOA reserves the right to turn down exhibition registrants who are unwilling to participate with other artists, if required.

Financial Considerations – Because of the generous sponsorships from Parker Pad & Printing and Viper Marketing, the volunteer efforts of the KLCOA organizers and the willingness of local media and businesses to promote our event, AOTD will charge a minimum fee per location to participate but collects contributions from all exhibitors which along with contributions from visitors are donated to the Haliburton Highlands Arts Council - Artists in the Schools program. www.haliburtonarts.on.ca/programs/artists-in-the-schools/

As part of our continuing donation to the Artist in the School program, this year we are looking at the following:

- Your choice of either a registration fee for each artist of \$50 or a donation of your work to be auctioned off at the Ladies of the Lake Luncheon. The benefits of choosing the auction item donation is that will allow a large group of potential shoppers to see your work before the AOTD weekend.
- We ask that every exhibitor who sells work during the AOTD weekend (or receives commissions) to donate a portion of their sales. In the past artists have contributed between 5-10% of total sales.

All selling arrangements will be at the discretion of the exhibitor and any tax liabilities will be the sole responsibility of the exhibitor.

Exhibitor Code of Conduct:

- Exhibitors will display their work in an attractive manner from 10am–4pm on July 13 and from 10am–3pm on July 14. While exhibiting outdoors is encouraged, in the event of rain, it is hoped that exhibitors will make arrangements to display indoors during the times noted above
- The work displayed will be in keeping with that indicated in the Registration form and similar to the photographs provided
- Exhibitors will welcome visitors in the spirit of the Kennis community and conduct themselves professionally
- Signage details will be communicated to all participants closer to the event

Exhibitors agree to read all materials provided by the KLCOA with respect to Art on the Dock and follow the AOTD rules & program.
