Kennisis Lakes' Art on the Dock (AOTD) has established itself as a very special annual event for the Kennisis Lake Community. From the beginning, rather than a formal juried show, it was envisioned as a community event, where creative people on the lake could showcase their artistic talents and skills. It embraces many media – pottery, glass sculpture, photography, carving, painting, furniture making, etc. While we do not have many formal rules, we require primary participating exhibitors to have property on the Kennisis lakes (or to have a strong family connection), to agree to participate for both full days of this event, and to offer hand-made rather than commercially/mass produced or factory-made & embellished items.

**Deadline for exhibitor registration: April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Please email completed registration forms to** <u>janis@parkerpad.com</u>. Please note that this is a strict deadline – Exhibitor registrations received after April 30th may not be included in the brochure or other printed & electronic event promotion.

Who can exhibit? The primary exhibitor must be a property owner (or immediate family member) on the Kennisis Lakes and a current member of the Kennisis Lake Cottage Owners' Association. Primary exhibitors are welcome to invite family members or friends to exhibit with them as quest exhibitors. Please note that to make the event manageable for visitors, we will constrain the number of exhibit locations to a maximum of 10. Preference will be given to locations with more than one artist exhibiting. We would appreciate it if you would be willing to host other artists or if you would be willing to join another exhibit location. Once registration closes on April 30th, we will contact artists where necessary to make arrangements to attain a maximum of 10 exhibit locations. While every attempt will be made to accommodate artists in their preferred locations, the AOTD committee reserves the right to turn down exhibition registrants who are unwilling to participate with other artists, if required.

**Financial Considerations** – Because of the generous sponsorships from our lake community & the volunteer efforts of the KLCOA organizers & the willingness of local media and businesses to promote our event, AOTD will charge for members of the KLCOA & their immediate family: \$50 per artist. Visiting Artists: \$100 each. Visiting artists must be approved by the AOTD committee.

This registration fee plus mandatory contribution of a suggested 10% of sales allows our event to make a significant contribution to the Haliburton community.

We have over the last 10 years donated over \$36,000 to the Haliburton Highlands ~ Art Council, and specifically their program which places local artists in schools and in the community.

## **Exhibitor Code of Conduct:**

- Exhibitors will display their work in an attractive manner from 10am – 5pm on Saturday and from 10am –3pm on Sunday. While exhibiting outdoors is encouraged, in the event of rain, it is hoped that exhibitors will make arrangements to display indoors during the times noted above
- The work displayed will be in keeping with that indicated in the Registration form and similar to the photographs provided
- Exhibitors will welcome visitors in the spirit of the Kennisis community and conduct themselves professionally
- Signage details will be communicated to all participants closer to the event

Exhibitors agree to read all materials provided by the KLCOA with respect to Art on the Dock and follow the AOTD rules and program.
